And so the Sheet Music charts finally ceased to be published. They had begun in 1940 as the instigator of recordings needing to be made, finally to becoming mainly produced as a consequence of hit records. The ending of these charts also coincided with the end of The Big Beat era which had begun around 1958 and was now being replaced with a more hard R&B sound, as well as folk and experimental music. It is hard to imagine what most people would have made of trying to play (and even sing!), from sheet music, songs such as "Purple Haze" by Jimi Hendrix and other heavy rock numbers of it's ilk. Sales did continue well into the 70s and even today some sheet music can be bought for contemporary pop songs.
