

Back in 1952 the only UK music charts available were the sales of Sheet Music which were mainly bought by musicians in the entertainment world that included professional and amateur singers and band leaders of the time. Other purchasers would include pub pianists and those who sang or played at home. The majority of people got their music from the radio which was then the BBC Light Programme and often played by the BBCs own orchestras and in-house singers. When a record was played, usually in request shows such as Housewives Choice, Two-Way Family Favourites, or Children's Favourites, the version played would tend to be a British cover version as they had a policy of British first.

Each record company had their own artists signed up exclusively to them and duets with anyone signed to another label was strictly not allowed. This resulted with when a song became popular each record label made sure they had a version available (sometimes more than 1 version). This is where the term "cover version" derives.

Towards the end of 1952 the New Musical Express decided it was time to do a chart based on Record Purchases in addition to Sheet Music sales (they continued with the latter well into the 1960s). But in line with the sheet music chart they separated the sides of the record which had the anomaly of often placing the 2 sides in different chart positions even though the sales were obviously the same. The accuracy of the first charts is debatable due to the very small returns and record store localities chosen.

However, there was another issue at the time. Due to the rivalries between the different Record Companies – They were not happy. Not only did they not want it known that another version was selling more than theirs, just as important was that this was going to highlight the popularity of American originals. These charts would for the first time advertise these alongside their British versions.

To appease the British Record Companies, after 18 months of the record charts, the New Musical Express decided to run a "UK only" Top 12 alongside their main one. Whether this pleased anybody we shall never know but it only survived just under 6 months when it was stopped. However just under 3 months later they extended their current Top 12 to a full Top 20 (American discs were included).

The following pages include a summary of all the "UK only" chart hits published and a summary showing highest chart positions and number of weeks.
